Shallow Entry Diving

The Goldfields Oasis 50m Indoor Pool has a depth at the shallow end of 1.2 m. All coaches are to complete the Shallow entry diving form as proof that the swimmers have been trained and are competent starters as a mechanism to minimise the risk factors associated with a competitive dive entry. Parent/guardian names and signatures are also required. Please ensure this form is completed for **all swimmers** and returned to the Meet Coordinator by **Friday February 16, 2024**.

Training Times – Friday Afternoon

Teams wishing to have a training session on Friday afternoon are asked to contact the Meet Coordinator by email by **Friday February 16, 2024**. Lanes and times will be allocated based on this response. Please indicate your approximate arrival time in town if you require a later session.

Please note that pool entry fees may be payable for the Friday Training Sessions. Goldfields Oasis entry fees are:

Adult Swimmers: \$7.00 Child Swimmers: \$5.00 Spectator: \$3.00

Warm up Saturday & Sunday

Teams wishing to have a warmup session on Saturday or Sunday are also asked to email the Meet Coordinator by **Friday February 16, 2024**. Lanes will be allocated based on these responses. Please note the indoor 25m leisure pool is reserved for competitors to warm up and cool down laps all day Saturday & Sunday (please note this pool is only 0.9m in depth so NO diving is allowed).

Clubs who do not respond will not be allocated a warm-up session

March Past- Theme GOLD

Teams will be required to assemble for the March Past by **7am on Saturday**. Teams will assemble on the adjacent outside netball courts as will be marked on the facility layout map and enter at 7:30 sharp.







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Officials Information

Officials Area – There is a designated area for the Officials in Multipurpose Room, as will be indicated on the facility map. Officials Lunch and refreshments will be available in this room.

Meeting – Pre-event officials briefing will take place at **7:00am on Saturday** in the official's area. This meeting will be for all personnel officiating over the weekend including Trainee Officials. Please be prompt. Officials will be in the March Past after this briefing.

Attire – All officials are required to wear black pants/shorts/skirt with a white shirt. Officials who have nominated themselves for 3 or more sessions will receive an official's shirt providing their nomination form was received by November 30th, 2023, we are unable to supply shirts for nominations received after Sunday January 14th, 2024.

If your club would prefer to use excel to submit entries, then please contact Ann Kulker (Chief Recorderann@kulker.com.au) before 9th February 2024 to organise a template specific to the club's division for your entries.

Please note:

- 8yr old swimmers may ONLY be entered into the 8-9 yr old events
- 8yr old swimmers may ONLY be entered into the 10 & under Relays
- 8yr old swimmers may NOT swim in any other age group or open events.
- Information on Splash and Dash Entries is also available at the above link

Relay entries (including swimmer's names and reserves) are required to be submitted electronically with the individual entries by **9pm Friday February 16, 2024**.

The attached Relay slips will only be required if there are changes to the swimmer's names or the order of the swimmers, noting that relay teams may only be adjusted to include previously named reserves. Names will be printed in the program based on the submitted names (excluding reserves)

Changes must be submitted by 7am Saturday for the Medley relays and 1pm Sunday for the Freestyle relays.





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Food

Included in this pack are order forms for lunches on Saturday & Sunday. All lunch orders will be catered by Subway with Footlong Sub Meal Deals \$18 and Six Inch subs, wraps & salad bowls meal deals for \$15. All meal deals include a bottle of water and cookie (randomly selected).

As mentioned in the second information pack, no dinner options are on offer due to the large variety of restaurants, pubs, and food outlets within Kalgoorlie- Boulder.

Due date for food orders is Friday February 9, 2024.

The Kalgoorlie Swimming Club will be offering Bacon and Egg burgers for Breakfast, along with coffee vans over the weekend. The Goldfields Oasis venue also has an independently run kiosk on-site selling a variety of food & drinks.

Programs

Team Bays

Team bays will be allocated in the Basketball Stadium adjacent to the Pool area on the west side of the complex. All teams will be allocated a bay up to 9m long by 3m wide.
