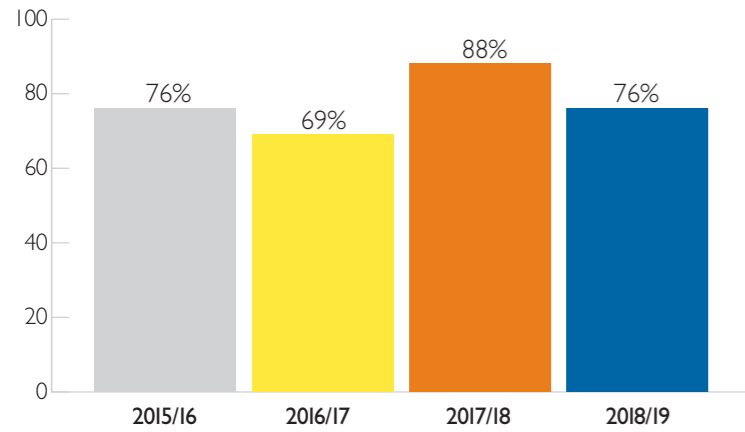


# 2019 Swimming WA Annual Club Survey Results

The Annual Club Survey is an opportunity for all Clubs to provide feedback on key strategic items. The survey is released in March each year with the results published annually.

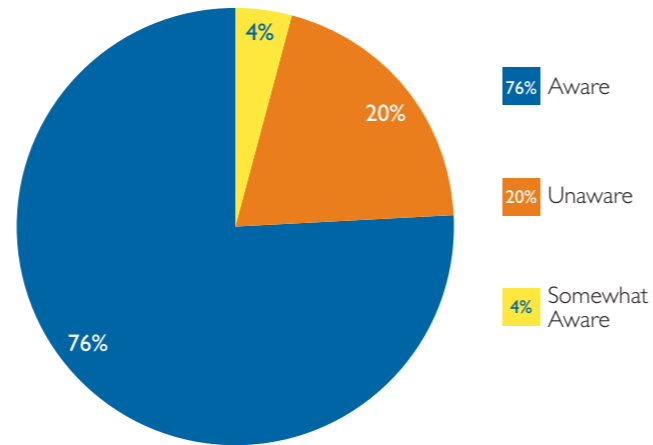
## CLUB SATISFACTION

Our Club is satisfied that Swimming WA makes decisions that represent the interest of the Club and its Members at all times.



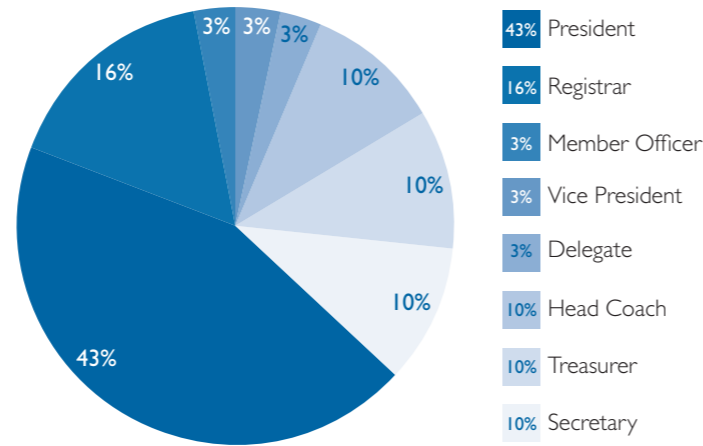
## MEET STRUCTURE

Our Club is aware of the types of competition available.

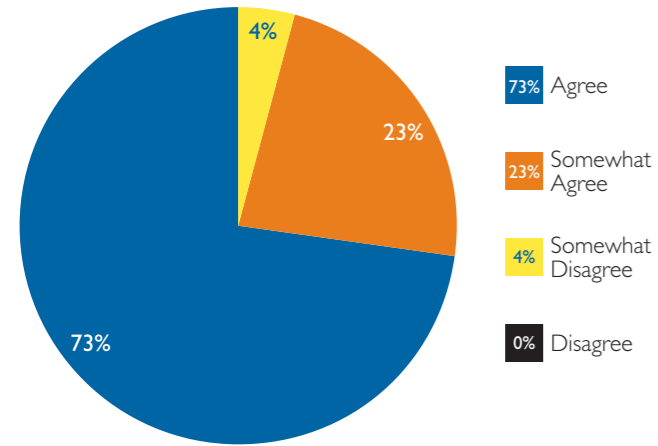

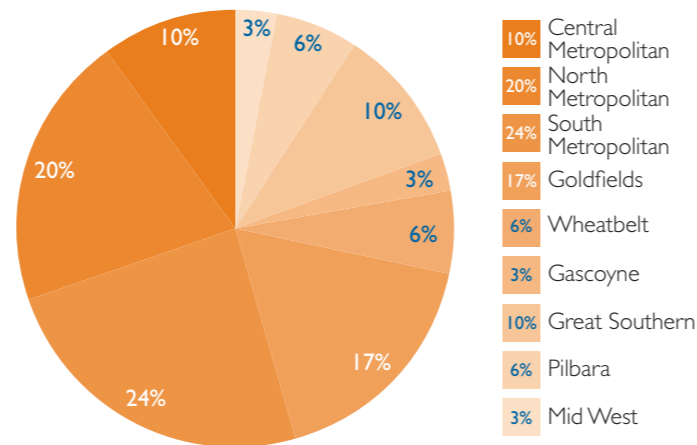
### DISTRIBUTION OF COMMITTEE POSITIONS

Our Club is pleased with how Swimming WA helps the Club to manage risks (e.g. Member Welfare Policy, Child Protection Policy, complaint handling etc.)



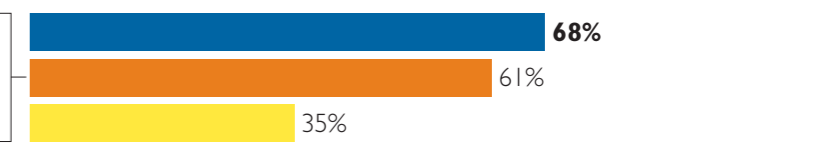
### MARKETING AND MEDIA

Our Club is satisfied with the Swimming WA Talent ID, performance strategy and Performance Pathway.



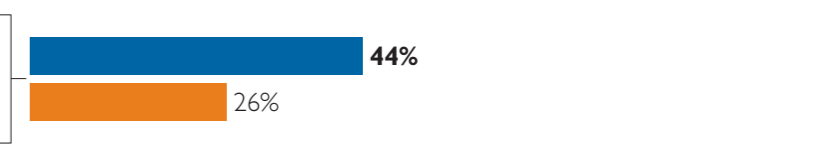
### OPEN WATER
