- Hold a current Police Clearance certificate; and
- Demonstrate a passion for swimming through a commitment to encourage best practice in skill acquisition whilst creating an environment that is team focused & enjoyable.

• Plan and deliver training programmes that challenge swimmers in a fun environment;

- Communicate with swimmers in a positive and supportive manner;
- Knowledge of current swimming and squad management practices;
- Strong time management and organisational skills with the ability to prioritise tasks and attending to multiple tasks simultaneously;

- Ability to work autonomously and as part of a team;
- Understanding of child safety;
