Scope

The purpose of this policy is to inform the selection of athletes for the WA Team competing at the Victoria Tri-Series Competition 2025.

This policy encompasses the following disciplines of the sport of swimming:

- Able Bodied Pool events
- Multi Class Pool events

Definitions

"Home State"	The State or Territory of Australia that the athlete considers	
	themselves as a representative of at national competition.	
Automatic Qualification	Selection into the respective squad is without discretion provided	
	the athlete meets stated athlete eligibility standards and selection	
	criteria.	
Benchmark Championship	Competitions that have been identified by a governing body as the	
	pinnacle competitions for an athlete's annual program.	
Heat	The race in a specific event that athletes will compete for placings	
	used to qualify for a final.	
Final	The race in a specific event that athletes will compete for final	
	placings, usually determined by placing in the preceeding heat	
	session.	
Performance Standards	An agreed time taken to complete a specified event, that is used to	
	inform athlete selection into the respective squad.	
Special Consideration	The consideration of an athlete for qualification, that does not meet	
	performance standards, due to circumstances outside the athlete's	
	control significantly impacting the ability to meet performance	
	standards.	
Swimming Australia	Governing Body for the sport of Swimming in Australia.	
Swimming WA	Governing Body for the sport of Swimming in Western Australia.	
Timed Final	The race in a specific event that athletes will compete for final

Selection	Able Bodied and Multi Class Events		
Criteria	Athletes will be assigned a priority ranking, based on the following:		
	- Priority One to Three, with One being first priority for selection and		
	Three being last priority for selection.		
	- If the number of athletes meeting the standard for Priority One to		
	Three exceeds maximum team size and composition rules, athletes		



will be further ranked within each priority by secondary criteria.

Priority One

Athletes whom are selected into the following 2025/2026 WA Performance Pathway Program Squads through <u>automatic qualification</u>, ranked by the selection panel in order of secondary criteria outlined below:

- WA Target Flippers Squad
- WA Flippers Squad

Secondary Criteria

A combination of the following will be considered by the selection in the ranking of athletes:

- Athletes' best % proximity to WA Flippers Squad performance standards at the benchmark championships, stated within the 2025/2026 WA Performance Pathway Program selection criteria, in either a heat, timed final or final
- Number of events whereby the athlete met automatic qualification performance standards for selection into the respective squad(s).
- Event profiles that best contribute to the team's performance needs

Priority Two

Athletes whom are selected into the following 2025/2026 WA Performance Pathway Program Squads through <u>special consideration</u>, ranked by the selection panel in order of secondary criteria outlined below:

- WA Target Flippers Squad
- WA Flippers Squad

Secondary Criteria

A combination of the following will be considered by the selection panel in the ranking of athletes:

- Athletes' best % proximity to WA Flippers Squad performance standards at the benchmark championships, stated within the 2025/2026 WA Performance Pathway Program selection criteria, in either a heat, timed final or final
- Number of events whereby the athlete met automatic qualification performance standards for selection into the respective squad(s).
- Event profiles that best contribute to the team's performance needs

Priority Three

Athletes whom are selected into the following 2025/2026 WA Performance Pathway Program Squad, ranked by the selection panel in order of secondary criteria outlined below:

- WA Development Squad

Secondary Criteria

A combination of the following will be considered by the selection panel in the ranking of athletes:

- Athletes' best % proximity to WA Flippers Squad performance

Process

Selection	First Round of Selection: Priority One and Two				
Process	 Athletes to accept the position in the WA Performance Pathway 				
	Program and indicate intent for selection for this team by the stated deadline				
	 Selection panel to confirm priority ranking of athlete and notify 				
	athlete of selection or, if not selected, priority ranking within seven				
	(7) days following the stated deadline.				
	- Athletes to pay the deposit and complete financial and administrative				
	tasks by the allotted deadlines.				
	Second Round of Selection: Priority Three				
	 Selection panel to confirm priority ranking of athletes within fourteen (14) days following the notification of athletes within the first round of selection. As team size permits, selection panel to confirm and notify athlete of selection for this team as soon as practically possible. 				
	- Athletes to confirm intent for selection and pay the deposit within				
	fourteen (14) days following notification of selection.				
	 Athletes to complete all remaining financial and administrative tasks by the allotted deadlines. 				
	Note: Athletes ranked within Priority Three, whom are not selected, will not be notified of their priority ranking.
