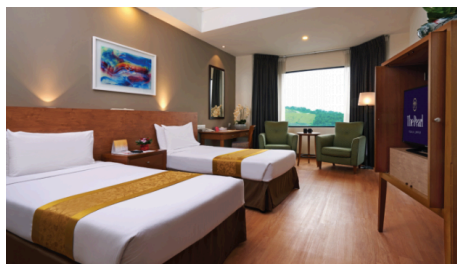
Coach Selection Criteria

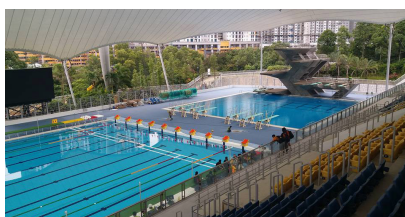
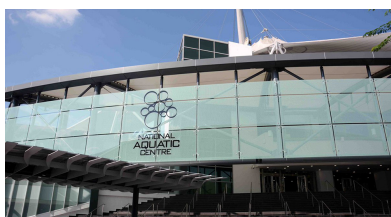
Accommodation will be at *The Pearl Kuala Lumpur*.

It is a unique opportunity to gain a preview and develop the skills for of what lays ahead as swimmer's progress through their career.
- To benefit from the experience of self-management and exposure to the competitive training (in the camp environment) for a week under the guidance of one of Australia's most experienced national coaches.

Coach Selection Criteria & Process

Selection is based on swimmers' performances at the 2019 Hancock Prospecting Australian Age Swimming Championships.

Flights, Accommodation and Meals will be covered by Swimming WA. Coaches are to provide their own incidentals, personal expenses and snacks.

Athlete Eligibility	To be considered for selection, a swimmer must be: a) Be a current registered member of Swimming WA; b) Coaching in WA c) Be an Australian Citizen;
Selection Criteria	To be selected, a coach must be; a) Member of ASCTA b) Current Coaching License holder c) Prepared and coached a swimmer in the target group: females 15 and 16; males 15 to 17 who won an individual medal at the 2019 Hancock Prospecting Australian Age Championships. d) There must be a gender balance with the two coaches (Leigh Nugent and the appointed team coach) who will be managing the team in Malaysia.
Team Commitments	All coaches will be required to: a) Sign a Swimming WA team Agreement which outlines the commitment of being selected on this squad b) Enter into this Agreement with their Club who will support the selection c) Attend and travel with the team to the Western Australian 2019 Malaysian Training Camp; from Tuesday 8 October – Sunday 13 October 2019
Note	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Swimming WA may amend the selection criteria at any time at its discretion. Swimming WA decision is final and no appeal process regarding a decision will be entered into. Swimming WA reserves the right to refuse selection regardless of achievement or to consider selection for those swimmers who may not meet the selection criteria.
