

## Performance Pathway Team

### Athlete Selection Criteria 2025

#### Amendment

Swimming WA reserves the right to amend any component of this version of the document. Publications of versions will be articulated within this document.

#### Scope

The purpose of this policy is to inform the selection of athletes for the Performance Pathway Team competing in State Relay Events at 2025 Australian Age Championships.

#### Definitions

“Home State”	The State or Territory of Australia that the athlete considers themselves as a representative of at national competition.
Automatic Qualification	Selection into the respective squad is without discretion provided the athlete meets stated athlete eligibility standards and selection criteria.
Final	The race in a specific event that athletes will compete for final placings, usually determined by placing in the preceeding heat session.
Performance Standards	An agreed time taken to complete a specified event, that is used to inform athlete selection into the respective squad.
Swimming Australia	Governing Body for the sport of Swimming in Australia.
Swimming WA	Governing Body for the sport of Swimming in Western Australia.
Timed Final	The race in a specific event that athletes will compete for final placings, where there was no preceeding heat session.
World Aquatics	Governing Body for the sport of Swimming (globally).

Athlete Eligibility	<p>To be considered for selection, a swimmer must:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Be an Australian Citizen</li> <li>- Be a current Swimming WA Annual Member</li> <li>- Declare Western Australia as their “home state”</li> <li>- Be eligible under World Aquatics regulations to represent Australia at the upcoming international benchmark championship as defined by Swimming Australia</li> </ul>

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Be considered in good standing by the Swimming WA affiliated club, Swimming WA and Swimming Australia</li> <li>- Be a registered participant in 2025 Australian Age Championships</li> <li>- Have registered their intent for selection, using Swim Central by the nominated closing date of 09:00am March 17, 2025.</li> </ul>
Selection Criteria	<p>This selection criteria is applied in accordance with event-specific regulations supplied by Swimming Australia.</p> <p>Rankings will be formulated using official times recorded from nominated athletes in Results Central in order of fastest to slowest, from December 13 2024 to March 17, 2025.</p> <p><b>Freestyle Relays</b> Four (4) highest ranked athletes in accordance with event-specific regulations, with the next four (4) highest ranked athletes named as reserves.</p> <p><b>Medley Relays</b> Fastest combination of four (4) athletes in accordance with event-specific regulations.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Four (4) reserves will be named for each event. The selection panel has full discretion on naming reserves based on athlete position in rankings and athlete adaptability to different strokes.</li> </ul>

## Process

Selection Process	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Selection panel notified of athlete nominations to be considered for selection.</li> <li>- Selection panel to confirm selections by 9.00am AEDST Thursday March 20</li> <li>- Athlete notified of selection as soon as practically possible following the confirmation of athlete selection.</li> </ul>
Selection Panel	Swimming WA Pathways Coordinator or equivalent Appointed 2025 WA Relay Team coach/es
Appeals Process	Disputes relating to decisions and application of this criteria are bound by Part Four (Dispute Resolution, Mediation and Disciplinary Action) of the Swimming WA Constitution which can be found <a href="#">here</a> .
