Aqua Technics Awards and Scholarships 2020/21

Through our fantastic supporter Aqua Technics, the following awards and scholarships are provided each year:

Ben Beale Memorial Award

The Ben Beale Memorial Award has been established to celebrate and recognise those 'champions' of the Swimming WA Club environment. This perpetual Award will annually celebrate the 'Best Club person' (must be a current athlete) within a Swimming WA Club. The athlete must be aged 14 years or over at I May of the year of their nomination. The Award is designed to increase the winner's leadership skills and experience, with the objective that they will stay in the sport long term, and also contribute to their Club in a meaningful manner, well beyond their days as an athlete.

Aqua Technics Regional Rising Star Award

The Aqua Technics Regional Rising Star Award has been established to assist families meet some of the costs associated with the sport of swimming. The Award will be the responsibility of each Regional Committee who will recognise one (1) male and one (1) female athlete who live and swim at a Swimming WA Club within their Region. The athlete must be aged between 9 and 12 years as at 1 September. The Award is designed to recognise the potential of the athlete who is considered by the Regional Committee to possess talent, that may see them develop into a swimmer that is one of the best within that Region.

Aqua Technics Travel Scholarship

The Aqua Technics Travel Scholarship has been established to assist families meet some of the costs associated with the sport of swimming at National level. The Scholarship will be the responsibility of the Swimming WA Management who will recognise one (1) athlete (male or female) who swim with a Swimming WA Club, no matter where that Club is based in the State. The athlete must be aged 15 and 17 years of age at 31 March. The Scholarship is designed to recognise the potential of the athlete who is considered by Swimming WA Performance staff to possess the talent to compete at National level or beyond.



Important:

Qualification for this Membership category is based on age at the start of the 2020/21 season (1 October 2020) or at the time of Membership purchase, whichever is the latter.

Should the swimmer turn 9 years of age during the 2020/21 season, the option is available to upgrade to an Annual, Seasonal, or Pathway Membership option to enable the swimmer to access benefits of these Membership categories. This will result in an upgrade fee.

Junior Dolphins 5-7 years of age

Junior Dolphins Membership for children aged 7 years and under who are graduating from a Learn to Swim School and wish to explore the social environment of a swimming Club, as well as preserving development opportunities.

Junior Dolphins Members (aged 5-7 years) have access to:

• Junior Dolphins Carnivals

Open Water Membership Annual

To provide Open Water Swimming swimmers the opportunity to align with a Club and provide incentive for swimmers to compete in more than one Open Water Swimming event. For Members 9+ years.

Open Water Swimming Membership has access to:

- All Open Water Swimming rounds
- Free entry to launch and presentation functions

Important:

Open Water Swimming Membership does not enable the swimmer to compete at Open Water Swimming State Championships or Open Water Swimming Nationals. If this is the objective of the swimmer, they must register as a full Annual or Seasonal Member (depending on which is appropriate to the swimmers situation).

Club Operational Memberships

Coach

The Swimming WA Coach Membership category is available for all current ASCTA/Swimming Australia accredited Coaches or Coaches working towards their Swimming Australia accreditation within 2 years of taking up the Swimming WA Coach Membership. This Membership provides Coaches the opportunity to be aligned with the sport of competitive swimming in Western Australia.

Technical Official

The Swimming WA Technical Officials Membership is available for suitably qualified or aspiring Technical Officials.

Club Committee Member

Club Committee Membership ensures access to Member programmes and benefits. Club Committee Members are protected by insurance at any time when completing Club related activities, participating at the Club or travelling to and from Club activities.

Swimming WA Supporting Memberships

Parent/Supporter Member

This applies to parents and supporters of competitors that are children under the age of 18 years additionally supporters who are registered with the Club. Parents and supporters with this Membership are protected by insurance at anytime when completing Club related activities, participating at the Club or travelling to and from Club activities.

Individual Member

The Individual Membership category applies to any person who wishes to be apart of the associaition withouth having to be connect to a Club. This is for non-competitive Members ONLY.

Swimming WA Life Member

Life Members are awarded this Membership at the AGM Conference by Swimming WA, nominated by Members and Clubs for their long-standing contribution and dedication to the sport.

Important:

- Age of Member and category is based on the age at 1 October 2020 or at the time of Membership purchase for the 2020/21 season, whichever is the latter.
- If a Member is under 18 years of age, it is compulsory for the parent/guardian to sign up to Swimming WA and the Club taking a Parent/ Guardian Membership and have their profiles linked with the under 18 Member.
- To participate in the Open Water Swimming events an Open Water Swimming Membership or an Open Water Swimming Day Pass is required for any non Swimming WA Members 9 years +.





Swimming WA is committed to ensuring all Clubs are affiliated by 26 June 2020 Swimming WA Clubs must have all affiliation forms completed, policy declarations signed and provide Swimming WA with an updated Club financial statement, a Club and Coach agreement and Club affiliation fee no later than 26 June 2020.

Failure to return these documents to Swimming WA, could result in your Club failing to affiliate for the 2020/21 season, which will affect your Members' ability to enter competitions.

If your Club also does not meet the minimum Membership affiliation requirements (all Members registered with Swimming WA), your Club could also fail to affiliate. As per clause 5.2(b) of the Swimming WA Board by-laws and policies, regional Clubs must have a minimum of 12 Annual/Seasonal Members (excluding Junior Dolphins Members) and 8 non-swimmer Members. Metropolitan Clubs must have a minimum of 25 Annual/Seasonal Members (excluding Junior Dolphins Members) and 12 non-swimmer Members.

Insurance

What is Public Liability Insurance?

Public Liability insurance is designed to protect you and your Club from legal and / or medical costs that arise from an incident connected to your activities.

It protects you against the financial risk of being found liable to a third party for death or injury, loss of or damage to property or 'pure economic' loss resulting from your negligence.

Liability insurance is absolutely essential to every business owner and sports Club.

What cover is typically provided within an extended Public Liability policy?

Public Liability coverage can have up to three different sections:

Public Liability – legal action against the Insured for breached duty of care.

Products Liability – legal action against the Insured for sale of faulty products.

Errors and Omissions – legal action against the Insured for negligent acts / advice.

You will generally find that you are covered in all areas as part of a standard Public Liability policy.

What cover is typically excluded from a Public Liability policy?

Gross Negligence

If your business or Club is not deemed to be a safe environment caused by deliberate neglect then your policy may become void. In this instance, you are personally liable for the financial burden of the liability claim.

Excess

Claims have an excess of \$1,000. Claims of a sexual molestation nature attracts a \$10,000 excess.

This excess is not covered by the insurance policy.

Errors and Omissions

Professional Indemnity insurance is designed to cover you in the event of a claim made against you because of professional negligence caused by mistakes, bad advice or general poor workmanship.

It provides indemnity cover if a person suffers a loss – either material, financial or physical – directly attributed to negligent acts.

Examples of Public Liability Claims

Example I - a sporting participant sustains a knee injury after tripping in a pothole on a sports field whilst participating in a game. He sues the Club for failing to provide a duty of care to the participants and their playing conditions.

Example 2 - a parent is walking around the pool deck and trips on an extension lead that the Club has run along the ground to power a starting machine.

He suffers personal injury and sues the Club for negligence.

Negligence is doing something without a reasonable amount of care, or failing to do something which might reasonably have been done to prevent the incident.
