Your duties:

- Plan, deliver and manage the squad's program
- Attend target meets and club time trials when required.

- Work with swimmers and coaches to encourage positive word of mouth and, support members' and the Club's Management Committee (MC) to promote and develop the club.

- Participate in professional development opportunities (ASCTA, Southwest Region)

- Hold a current ASCTA membership (or willingness to obtain one)
