

What is a Junior Dolphin?

A Junior Dolphin is a swimmer aged five to eight years engaged in swimming at a learn-to-swim or squad level.

What is a Junior Dolphin Carnival?

Junior Dolphin carnivals are an exciting initiative from Swimming WA in which children aged five to eight years can have fun with their friends and practice their swimming in a safe, social and non-competitive environment. Along with Swimming WA affiliated swimming Clubs and Regions, primary schools are invited to take part in the programme and host a Junior Dolphin carnival to assist students with their water confidence and swimming participation.

A Junior Dolphin carnival is designed to run for a maximum of one hour, comprised of a series of fun team-based activities and races with a strong focus on participation, not competition.

The carnivals can be stand alone or held at the beginning of an existing Club swim Meet or SunSmart Splash & Dash carnival. Host Clubs, Regions or schools are strongly encouraged use accredited swimming instructors or accredited coaches who run a series of activities and games. A carnival consists of a whole group warmup, a round robin of activities and games, a whole group game or relay, and a wrap up, including discussion about the Junior Dolphin Swimming WA Membership and how participants can join their local Club.

Swimming instructors or coaches can undertake a Swimming WA endorsed Junior Dolphin training course to build their capacity to facilitate the carnivals and development of young swimmers. Junior Dolphin Membership

Responsibilities

Swimming WA will be responsible for:

- Promotion of Club programme following the carnival;
- A carnival checklist;
- Marketing resources;
- Sponsor materials and signage to be displayed at the carnival;
- Registration page and link (can be modified at Host's request);
- Hands on assistance (if required) to the Club, Region or school's first carnival;
- A list of recommended vendors whom the Club, Region or school may engage for their carnival at their own cost; and
- Selected giveaways (while stocks last);
- Use of inflatable boats or other pool equipment, where needed.

Host Clubs, Regions and schools will be responsible for:

- Promote the carnival within the Swimming WA guidelines;
- Distribute Junior Dolphin merchandise to participants;
- Host and deliver the carnival on their assigned date;
- Take photos throughout their carnival or hire a photographer, and send the images to Swimming WA upon completion;
- Share copies of photos or media from the carnival with Swimming WA using the hashtag #DoIFUN;
- Consider hosting their carnival in con junction with a Club Night or SunSmart Splash & Dash carnival;
- Return any unused marketing resources;
- Return sponsor signage and materials.

In the spirit of Swimming, host Clubs should not approach any swimmer who is already a member of another Swimming Club. Swimming WA strongly encourages all Clubs to follow up with non-Members prior to and following their Junior Dolphin carnival.


