The Open Water Secondary Schools Championships is back for 2024!

Our inaugural year in 2023 saw over 430 participants from 35 schools and it's only going to get bigger and better from here.

The intention of this competition is to expand into the next generation of open water swimmers and continue to emphasise participation in those who may not want to focus on competitive pool swimming.

These Championships are open to all secondary schools across the metropolitan and regional areas and will see schools compete across multiple distances.

Technical Officials Hire

The purpose of the Technical Officials hire for schools is to allow schools to facilitate higher quality carnivals that can register official times as per Swimming WA guidelines. These official times can be logged accordingly with Swimming WA's database and can be used as qualifying times into Swimming WA meets. Roles that are typically utilised are Starter, Referee and Judge of Stroke.

Benefits of Hiring Technical Officials:

- Improves the quality of the meet which enhances the association/school's reputation of the delivery of sporting events.
- Increases the profile of the school within the swimming community.
- Better practice and preparation for inter-association or inter-school competitions.
- Opportunity for talent identification of athletes which can provide a connection to affiliated Swimming WA clubs.

- Opportunities for current members to get official times through their association/school carnivals.
- Builds relationships with Swimming WA, the peak body for swimming in WA as well as the Technical Officials.

2024-2025 Pricing:

- \$125.00 booking fee PER event (after 3 events booking fee will only be \$50.00 per event).
- \$125.00 per Technical Official per event.

Timing Hire and Carnival Support

The purpose of Timing Hire and Carnival Support is to provide primary and secondary schools support when planning and actioning their school swimming carnivals. Without having expertise in this area teachers can waste a lot of time, fall behind in their timeline and quadruple-handle results which causes a lot more stress. Swimming WA can assist schools run their swimming carnivals more effectively, and in turn enhances the school's brand and reputation in the wider community.

Benefits of Hiring Timing Equipment:

- Decreases the load and stress on teachers on an already busy carnival day.
- Provides a higher-quality meet and opportunity for students to get times for inter-school carnivals.
- Option of booking 1-2 timing assistants to attend the school carnival to help with the smooth setup and running of equipment.

Option 2: Timing Equipment & Timing Assistant

- \$450.00 day hire fee (free day hire for SWA affiliated swimming clubs).
- All bookings must be made by the school.
- \$50.00 per hour for Timing Assistant (minimum 3 hours).
- \$45.00 per hour for a secondary Timing Assistant (minimum 3 hours).
- Hire includes 1x temporary tattoo per participant.
- \$125.00 cancellation fee (retention of the booking fee) will be charged for any cancellation within 24 hours of a booking.

Learn To Race Clinics

The purpose of the Learn To Race Clinics is for Swimming WA accredited coaches to conduct specialised training sessions for schools to enhance their performances at an inter-school or inter-association carnival. It also will provide school teachers expert help when teaching the following techniques of swimming; dives, starts, turns and finishes. Swimming WA can also promote our affiliated clubs based on school location for anyone that is interested in competitive swimming but isn't yet a member.

Benefits of Learn To Race Clinics:

- Connection of schools to accredited swimming coaches.
- Takes the pressure off teachers to teach certain aspects of swimming.
- Improves student's ability to perform better at school or inter-school carnivals.
- Opportunity for talent identification of athletes which can provide a connection to affiliated Swimming WA clubs.
- Increase the profile of swimming within your school and increases swimming participation across the state.
- Showcases your school's leadership within the aquatic space in providing excellent opportunities for your students to be the best in the water.

Learn To Race Clinic Details:

 - 4x coaches with 10 participants per coach.
 - Focus on starts, dives, turns, finishes (1x coach per focus).
 - Rotate groups after 15 mins (participants will have a chance to work with all coaches).

 - Can host back-to-back Learn To Race clinics.
 - Coaches must have a current Swimming WA membership, current coaching accreditation and current Working With Children Check.
