

JUNIOR SQUAD COACH

UWA WEST COAST SWIMMING CLUB

UWSC operates a successful swimming squad program at HBF Stadium in Mt Claremont and the UWA Aquatic Centre in Crawley. The Club offers programs from junior squads through to national-level representative squads.

UWA-West Coast is one of the most successful swimming clubs in WA and has won the A-Division Premierships for the last 5 years. The Club boasts an enviable performance record with 58 swimmers qualifying for 2020 national championship events, including Age, Open and Multi-Class national championships, Open Water Nationals and Olympic Trials.

The Club is responsible for the delivery of coaching and squad. We are experiencing a high demand for our sessions and can offer 3 - 8 hours of junior sessions per week, plus cover opportunities. This may increase throughout the term.

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- Delivery of squad sessions in line with the Junior Coaching Co-Ordinator's program.
- Demonstration of a willingness to learn and coaching expertise
- Attend and support athlete participation at local and state competitions, and other development activities as requested by the Club-approved manager
- Completion of all required administration, for example, timesheet submissions, squad programming, attendance.
- Actively work under the guidance of the Club approved manager to support all squad programs, across multiple club training locations.
- Promote and develop the profile of the Club within the swimming and wider sporting community.
- Other duties as directed
- Split shifts including early mornings and afternoon / evenings

- ASCTA SAT-CS or Bronze (Development) coaching licence (preferred)
- 2 years or more of swimming/coaching experience (preferred)
- Current WA Working with Children Check Card
