Ideally this coach will also have a passion for coaching all levels and ages including school and adult swimmers.

The successful applicant will be tasked with designing and coaching both competitive juniors, assisting with our age programme and non-competitive programs.

Kirby Swim's coaching programs have catered to all ages since 2002. From specifically designed Rottneest Channel programs, junior and mini-squad fitness programs to school PSA/IGSSA programs (CCGS winning 8 of the PSA titles since 2008) all of which underpin the elite Westside 'club' programs that have had great success. The highlight thus far, Olympic representation (K. Radford Rio 2016, 10 km OWS, Team NZL).

The successful applicant will embrace ideals and values that promote a positive and nurturing environment to develop an individual's esteem, confidence, habits, discipline, and motivation.

Duties:

- Design competitive junior development and non-competitive senior squad programs, manage, supervise, and coach development and senior squads.
- Work collaboratively with the head coach and coaching team.
- Prepare swimmers for and attend targeted competitions.
- Communicate in a positive, effective, and timely manner with swimmers, parents and others as required.
- Attend coaches' meetings when required.
- Participate in professional development opportunities (club, SWA, ASCTA).

Minimum qualifications and experience at the time of appointment:

- ASCTA SAT-CS or Bronze (Development) coaching licence (preferred)
- 3 years or more of swimming/coaching experience (preferred)
- Excellent interpersonal and communication skills including the ability to develop strong working relationships within the club.
- WA Working with Children Card.
- Current ASCTA membership.

Working hours and pay

- 12-18 hours Coaching/ Supervision of squad training on pool deck. May involve mornings, afternoon, evening sessions (Monday to Saturday).
- 3-5 hours Administration. Directly related to squad planning, coaching, swim meet preparation, monitoring of swimmer progress and meeting attendance.
- Some weekend work for competition attendance.
- The hourly rate payable will be dependent on the qualifications and experience of the successful applicant.
- Attendance at swim meets will be paid as a fixed daily rate.
