



York Dolphins Swimming Club – Coach



The York Swimming Club is seeking a coach for the 2021-22 season and beyond. Our swimming club is a small regional club of school aged swimmers that train and compete during the summer months. York Swimming Club fosters the enjoyment of swimming and competes at several regional events, including Country Pennants, and encourages swimmers to compete at the highest levels.

The coach would be required to:

- Plan and deliver training programmes that challenge swimmers in a fun environment.
- Communicate in a positive and supportive manner to swimmers.
- Work effectively with the York Swimming Club committee.
- Determine, prepare for and attend target meets during the swimming season including Country Pennants.
- Hold a current Working with Children Check and National Police Clearance.

The York Swimming Club will support the successful applicant in obtaining the relevant accreditations if required. The coach will need to hold an Australian Swimming Coaches and Teachers Accreditation (ASCTA) membership.

The York Swimming Club season typically runs from Nov 1 – March 31, with two after school 2 hr training sessions per week, and competitive club nights most weeks (2 hrs approx.). Training pauses during January for school holidays, however programmes for swimmers aiming for competitive events (e.g. Country Championships) may be required during this period.
