JUNIOR EXCELLENCE CLINIC BROOME

Swimming WA is offering an exciting opportunity for Junior Excellence (JX) Recipients and regional Members to attend a FREE Junior Excellence Clinic at the Broome Recreation and Aquatic Centre this Friday 28th of September in conjunction with the 2018 Kimberley Open Short Course Championships.

The Junior Excellence Programme is a Swimming Australia initiative that recognises, rewards and encourages junior swimmers who, through their development of aquatic skills and fitness, achieve a high standard of swimming excellence. This programme rewards Swimmers aged from nine (9) to sixteen (16) years, who accomplished times set by Swimming Australia, qualify at Gold, Silver, Bronze or Green standard, depending on their best performance/s during the season.

This year we had over 1700 Junior Excellence recipients from all over the state from as south as Esperance to as north as Broome. Swimming WA is excited to provide regional Junior Excellence participants in the Pilbara, Kimberley and surrounding regions with the opportunity to take part in this exclusive clinic, expecting over twenty (20) participants to attend. The Broome clinic will be ran by Cameron Hawthorn (Head Coach of Breakers WA) with guest appearances from Simone Fountain (nee Hankin) Olympic Gold Medalist 2000 Australian Women's Water Polo team and Broome local Talara-Jade Dixon who made the 2018 Gold Coast Commonwealth Games trials.

"I am very excited to be running a clinic in Broome. Junior excellence is a great programme to retain and develop our junior swimmers and I am looking forward to meeting and working with the swimmers from Broome and clubs throughout the Kimberley and Pilbara regions" stated Cameron Hawthorn, Head Coach, Breakers WA.

This clinic is a great opportunity for budding junior swimmers to learn from an experienced Head Coach and be inspired by a former Olympian and a promising swimming superstar.
