**WA CLUB PREMIERSHIPS ROUND 10
OPEN WATER SWIMMING SERIES
IN MANDURAH**

Town Beach in Mandurah is the venue for Round 10 of the Swimming WA Open Water Swim (OWS) Series on Monday 5 March 2018.

In addition to attracting more than 350 swimmers of all ages and fitness levels to tackle the variety of swim distances (500m, 1.25km, 2.5km and 5km), there will be a chance for Swimming Clubs from all over WA to compete for the Club Premiership.

Clubs will be competing for the *Jeanette Bailey Cup* along with the \$300 prize money for the most points received, as well as the *Kevin Holtom Club Participation Shield* for the club with the most participants in the open water swim event based on their membership size. Both Jeanette and Kevin are life members of Swimming WA and well-respected open water swimmers.

This family friendly event is supported by HHG Legal and the City of Mandurah.

As a major part of the Festival of Swimming this weekend the open water event caps off a busy weekend for Swimming WA, with their annual SunSmart Club Championships over the weekend at HBF Stadium, plus the WA Country Pennants event at Mandurah Aquatic and Recreation Centre that attracts 30 Swimming Clubs from regional WA.

Since commencing in November 2017, the OWS Series has had record crowds at their events at Cottesloe Beach, Busselton, Leighton, Scarborough, Coogee, Harvey Dam, Sorrento, Rockingham and most recently Shorehaven.

The OWS Series attracts more than 6000 swimmers over the summer. The final OWS event is on 24 March 2018 in the Swan River, adjacent to the WA Rowing Club.
