NOTE:

Clubs using only 4 Lanes - sequential from the pool edge, require three (3*) of the above "Technical Officials", three Timekeepers per Lane and have conducted the Club Night / Time Trial with Electronic Timing or Semi Automatic Timing.

**One Official cannot perform 2 roles at any one time.

Clubs using 8 Lanes require ALL (4) of the above "Technical Officials", three Timekeepers per Lane and have conducted the Club Night / Time Trial with Electronic Timing or Semi Automatic Timing. **One Official cannot perform 2 roles at any one time.

Times will be posted onto the National Results database as 'Approved' Times, which can be used to enter; State and National Championships.

For those Clubs that have conducted their Club Night / Time Trial with "Manual Stopwatches" need only supply two (2) Technical Officials as outlined above.

These times will still be uploaded to the National Results Database as 'Non Approved Times' which can still be used for entering 'on-line' or via a TM Entry File where 'No Qualifying Times' are required for entry to a Swim Meet.

NB: Only one (1) Application for Recognition of Results and only one (1) Electronic Results File can be submitted to SWA per month.
